# Add+VantageMR® (AVMR) Champion



AVMR Champion is a year-long course preparing participants to facilitate both AVMR Course 1 and Course 2 within district and provide on-going support for implementation. AVMR Champion participants are encouraged to offer AVMR Course 1 or Course 2 during the course.

The Champion course provides the opportunity for participants to learn how to deliver and support AVMR Course 1 and Course 2. Champions focus on supporting educators to apply Math Recovery principles to classroom mathematics instruction.

**AVMR Champions are certified to provide AVMR Course 1 and Course 2 to educators within their district.**

Local champions become an added resource of expertise and just-in-time support to ensure a sustained implementation of Math Recovery initiatives.

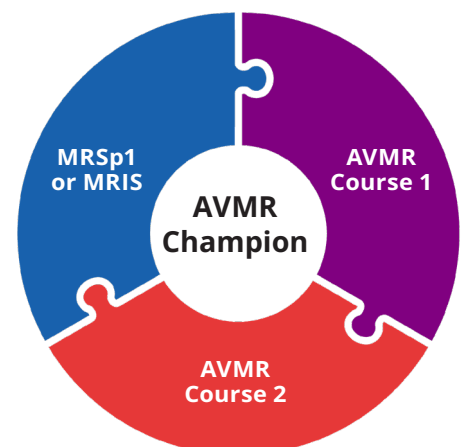

# Add+VantageMR® Fractions Champion

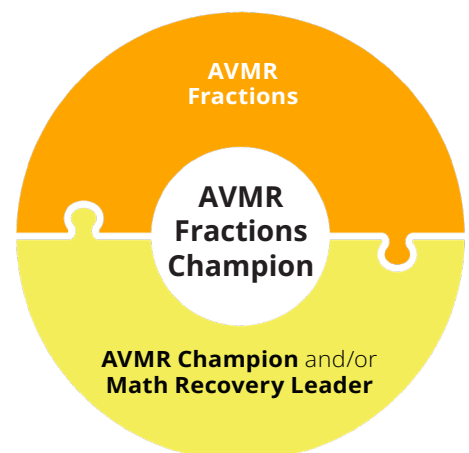

# MR Leader for Math Recovery Specialist (MRSp1), Part 1



MR Leader for Math Recovery Specialist, Part 1 is a 9-12 month course that develops a depth of knowledge necessary to deliver and certify the course within district, provide MRSp1 coaching and ongoing support, and refine and extend knowledge of Math Recovery content and pedagogy. MRSp1 Leader includes the assessment and teaching topics of addition and subtraction, structuring numbers, number word sequences, numeral identification, and conceptual place value.

MRSp1 Leader develops local leadership for effective district implementation of Math Recovery intervention and supports the implementation of other Math Recovery programs, including Ready Set Math, Add+VantageMR® Course 1, Course 2, and Fractions.

**Participating educators in MR Leader for Math Recovery Specialist, Part 1 are required to deliver an in-district MRSp1 course. Math Recovery leadership support is provided during and after the year-long course experience.**

# MR Leader for Math Recovery Specialist (MRSp2), Part 2



MR Leader for Math Recovery Specialist, Part 2 is a 9-12 month course that engages participants in an extended professional learning experience. This experience builds a high level of expertise in Math Recovery content and pedagogy specific to the assessment and teaching topics of higher decade addition and subtraction, addition and subtraction to 100, and multiplication and division.

MRSp2 Leader develops local leadership for effective district implementation of Math Recovery intervention and supports the implementation of other Math Recovery programs, including Ready Set Math, Add+VantageMR® Course 1, Course 2, and Fractions.

**Participating educators in MR Leader for Math Recovery Specialist, Part 2 are required to deliver an in-district MRSp2 course. Math Recovery leadership support is provided during and after the course experience.**
