



## Array Bingo

Players 3 - 5

### Materials

- Array Bingo Deck consisting of 80 array cards and 80 product cards (2 copies of each blackline master page provided)

### How to play

1. Deal 16 array cards to each player. Each player sets the array cards face up in a 4x4 array arrangement. The digit cards are placed in one pile face down in the play area.
2. Each player takes a turn being the caller. Player one chooses the top card from the digit card deck and says the number. The card is then placed at the bottom of the card deck.
3. All players check to see if they have the matching array for the called product. If a player has a match, then the card is turned upside down. If a player has two cards that match, only one of the cards is turned over.
4. Play continues until one player gets a BINGO: Four cards in a row turned face down.
